### CASE STUDY 8 – Training, WMG - University of Warwick/BAe Systems

Apprise Consulting were approached by WMG, part of Warwick University to assist in the development and delivery of a supply chain management course, concentrating on storage, distribution and outsourcing.

This Storage & Distribution training course has recently won a BAE Systems, Chairman's Bronze award in the Transferring Best Practice category. This is an outstanding achievement as competition for these awards is fierce.
