

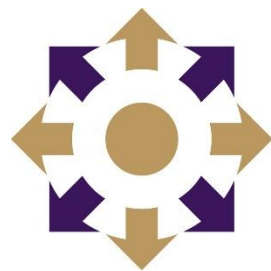
CASE STUDY 8 Training 512 Sheffield

Apprise Consulting, during its discussions with the owner of 512 Sheffield, were also asked to supply one to one coaching services to their warehouse manager and Director.

This involved running the warehouse management course supplied to the CILT, adjusting it to the requirements of 512 Sheffield and taking live examples from the existing warehouse operation to work through as part of the exercises.

The course was run over two separate days to fit in with work requirements and both attendees were given certificates having completed the course.

CASE STUDY 9 – Training, WMG - University of Warwick/BAE Systems

Apprise Consulting were approached by WMG, part of Warwick University to assist in the development and delivery of a supply chain management course, concentrating on storage, distribution and outsourcing.

This Storage & Distribution training course has recently won a BAE Systems, Chairman's Bronze award in the Transferring Best Practice category. This is an outstanding achievement as competition for these awards is fierce.

The Chairman's Award Scheme is an annual event within BAE Systems that recognises excellence in the successful exploitation of Innovation, the Transfer of Best Practice and in delivering Enhanced Customer Performance.

CASE STUDY 10 – Training, CILT and Flipkart India
